## \*Machine Language Program

Check the accompanying articles in RAINBOW on using each program. These programs may not run on your system. Please check each program in the magazine for system requirements. When using the programs SERL6V10, SERL6V11, PAR6V10 and PAR6V11, follow the instructions given at the beginning of the listing.

**Because of the large number of programs this month, we had to change the format of Rainbow On Tape for December. You will find the last six programs at the beginning of Side 2; backup copies of the longer listings are also on Side 2.**

**Special Note:** To exit from the RAINBOW ON TAPE MENU, press the (up arrow) key. You may have to press it several times until the screen clears. The MENU program has a section in machine language that may otherwise interfere with other programs you run later. After using any machine-language program (including some BASIC programs), turn your computer off and back on or type POKE 113,0:EXEC 40999 to clear it before loading another program.
